Debra is as a choral director, educator, composer, singer/songwriter and arts administrator. She set-up and arranges the repertoire for the Craigie Community Choir in Perth, an a cappella group that sings a wide ranging repertoire and has been lucky enough to sing with Runrig and as part of BBC's 'Last Choir Standing'. Debra currently leads Horsecross Voices and is involved in both Carse and Leven Voices community singing groups. She is also Vocal Director of the Hallelujah Clown Choir at Draiocht in Dublin, and has worked for the NHS to develop a singing project for COPD sufferers.

Debra won a Danny Kyle award at Celtic Connections in 2008 as a singer, and released a CD with a tour the following year. Her style draws from both the folk and jazz genres and she has worked with a wide range of individuals including Dougie MacLean and Frankie Armstrong. Debra also writes music for theatre with over 68 commissions for professional theatre in the UK and Ireland and for television and radio. She is an enthusiastic workshop leader; join her for a fun and inspirational evening of group singing.

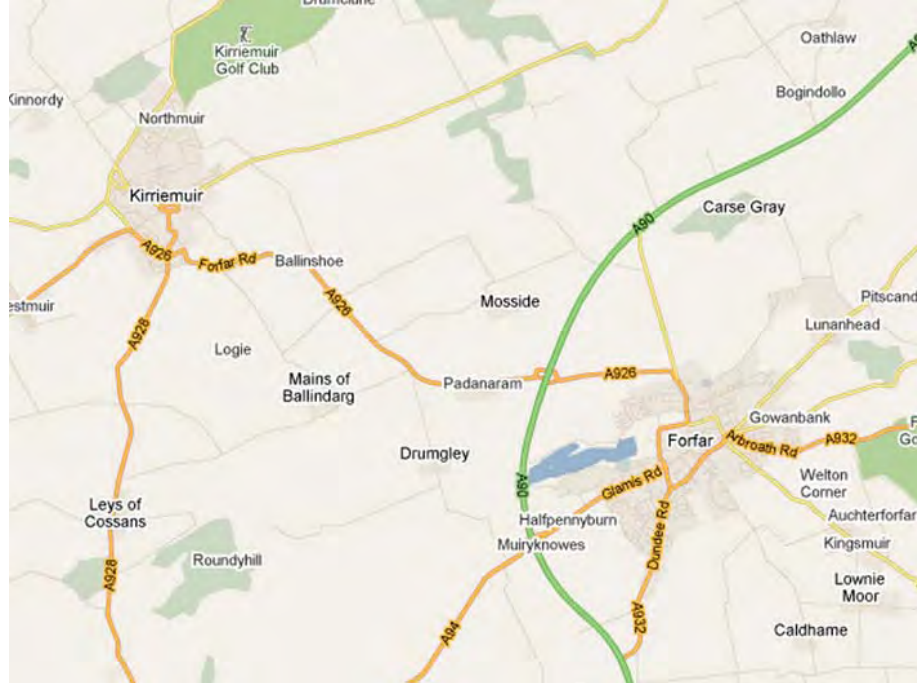
