In the past year, Robyn has performed live on BBC television, as part of the Commonwealth Games and to an audience of 8,000 at this year's Proms in the Park with the BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestra. She has also built a strong reputation as a song leader and tutor, keen to pass on her knowledge of traditional music to others.

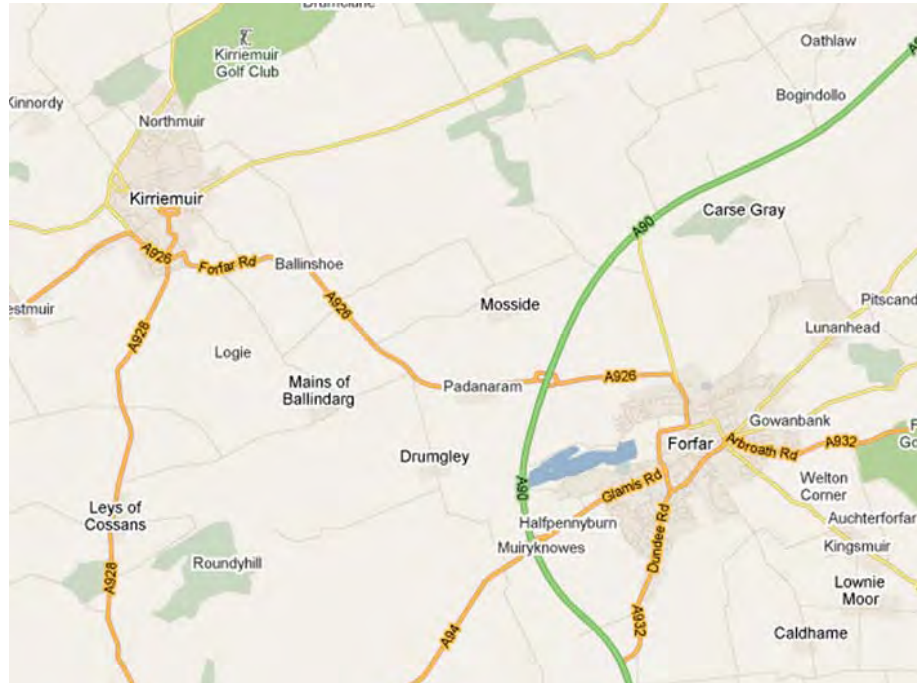
